The regular meeting of the Board of the South Carolina Conservation Bank was held at 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, October 24, 2006, at 1000 Assembly Street, Columbia, South Carolina. Notice of the date, time and place of the meeting was posted and mailed to the news media. Chairman Charles Lane presided at the meeting. Board member, Chad Prosser, was represented by Phil Gaines. Board Member, Gary Poliakoff, who is no longer on the Board, was represented by Joel Felder.

Staff members of SCDNR were present at the meeting as were various guests.

I. Call to Order

Chairman Lane called the meeting to order at 10:00 A.M. and welcomed everyone to the meeting. Chairman Lane stated that Freedom of Information Rules and Requirements have been met. Chairman Lane recognized Hank Stallworth and Rita Pardue from SCDNR.

II. Adoption of Minutes

Chairman Lane stated that the minutes of the last meeting have been mailed to the members of the Board and asked if there were any questions or comments on the minutes. Mr. Weston Adams made a motion that the minutes be approved. Mr. Elliott Close seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

III. Old Business

A. Update on Employee Position

Mr. Davant gave an update on the new employee position of Business Manager. An employee description had been mailed to Board members for their review. Once approval has been received from the Budget and Control Board, the position will be posted. Chairman Lane asked how long the process will take, and Mr. Davant advised approximately one month.

B. Web Site

Mr. Davant presented information concerning the new web site. The new web site will remain closed until final approval by Board members. The application will be on the web site and can be downloaded. Ms. Clark asked that the web site address be listed on all Bank documents. The web site should be on line within a week to ten days for the Board's review. After discussion, it was determined that the application should be available to be completed on line at a future date.

C. State Audit

Mr. Davant advised that the audit process was accomplished without any problems and that the Bank is in compliance. Chairman Lane advised that Palmetto Bluff is listed twice and was only awarded once. Mr. Davant advised that the auditors are aware of this error.

D. Heirs Property Report

Mr. Davant presented this report that is required to be presented as a part of the report by the SCCB. This report will comply with our statutory requirements.

E. Status of Ashley River Grant

Mr. Davant deferred to Chairman Lane for the status of this grant. Chairman Lane reported that the Board had approved \$6 million to go towards the purchase of the development rights of Poplar Grove, \$4 million has been distributed, and \$2 million has been awarded, but not distributed. Chairman Lane stated that he thought the Board needed to hold these funds until it was determined when they needed to be paid due to other ongoing negotiations by other parties. Weston Adams made a motion that the funds that are currently allocated to Ducks Unlimited for the Ashley River Project will be held for the Ashley River Project with the understanding that

4. Cannon Property, Sumter County 148 Acres. Amount Requested: \$200,000 Staff Recommendation: Grant of \$200,000

The owner of the property has managed it for wildlife. This is the first opportunity to work with the Congaree Land Trust. Jane Clarke from Congaree Land Trust made comments and answered questions. Mr. Elliott Close made the motion to fund this project in the amount of \$200,000. Mr. Weston Adams seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

5. DuPre House and Property, Spartanburg County 1.91 Acres. Amount Requested: \$250,000 Staff Recommendation: Grant of \$250,000

This property is an architectural and historical site in downtown Spartanburg. It will be managed as the Spartanburg Convention and Visitor Center. The SCCB funds can only be used for purchase of the property. After discussion, the Board recommended that Mr. Davant meet with the Department of Archives and History and the Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism about the criteria that they require. Mr. Weston Adams made the motion to fund the project in the

amount of \$250,000, with the condition that the remainder comes from other sources. Ms. Andrea Clark seconded the motion, and the motion carried, with Chairman Lane and Mr. Elliott Close voting against.

6. Edisto Packers Tract, Charleston County 30 Acres. Amount Requested: \$325,000 Staff Recommendation: Grant of \$325,000

This tract is to expand the ACE Basin National Wildlife Refuge. Mr. Tommy Miller made the motion to fund the project in the amount of \$325,000. Mr. Elliott Close seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

7. Firefly Forest (Lewis Property), Greenville County 121 Acres. Amount Requested: \$185,800 Staff Recommendation: Grant of \$185,800

This tract is a forest with a unique colony of fireflies located off of Highway 11. The colony of fireflies is one of three in the United States. The tract has very good natural resource values. Mr. Dana Leavitt from Upstate Forever made comments and answered questions. Ms. Andrea Clark made the motion to fund this project in the amount of \$185,800. Mr. Weston Adams seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

8. Langley Pond Park, Aiken County 64 Acres. Amount Requested: \$648,800 Staff Recommendation: Grant of \$648,800

This tract is located on Langley Pond. Aiken County Open Land Trust will own the property and

lease it to the Aiken Recreational Commission.

Langley Pond is the home court for the rowing team from the University of Georgia. Brian Sanders made comments and answered questions. Mr. Elliott Close made the motion to fund this project in the amount of \$648,800, contingent upon the County buying the 32 acres, donation of the pond and the 32 acres of wetlands. Mr. Weston Adams seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

9. Lawton Tract, Jasper County 1,074 Acres. Requested Amount: \$268,500 Staff Recommendation: Grant of \$268,500

This tract adjoins the Palachucola Tract owned by SCDNR. It is a Savannah River Preserve Proposal. The landowner will sell the easement at \$250 per acre. Mr. Noel Thorn made comments and answered questions. Mr. Tommy Miller made the motion to fund the project at \$268,500. Mr. Elliott Close seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

10. Milbury Plantation, Allendale County 10,400 Acres. Requested Amount: \$2,600,000 Staff Recommendation: Grant of \$2,600,000

This is a Savannah River Preserve Proposal.
The landowner (Pollard) will sell the easement at \$250 per acre. Mr. Noel Thorn made comments and answered questions. Ms. Andrea Clark made the motion to fund the project at \$2,600,000. Mr. Tommy Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

This property is located on St. Helena Island, one mile from the Penn Center. A representative from the Beaufort County Open Land Trust made comments and answered questions. The property was appraised at \$1,680,000. Mr. Weston Adams made the motion to fund the project at \$420,000, contingent upon the other funding committed. Ms. Andrea Clark seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

12. Segars Mill Pond Property, Darlington County 546 Acres. Amount Requested: \$2,500,000 Staff Recommendation: There is some concern about the percentage amount of the easement deduction.

Still negotiating with the Segars family.

This request is from the last application period. The amount of the request has been reduced and the acreage has been lowered. It has an old mill pond with historical significance. It is located next to the Segars-McKinnon Heritage Trust tract. Mr. Davant advised the Board that he had offered to pay the amount of \$2,500,000 in two installments. Mr. Jay James made comments and answered questions. After discussion of how the total funds would be paid, Mr. Weston Adams made the motion to fund the project in the amount of \$2,500,000 out of 2006 funds, and if all funds are not available, fund the balance from 2007, contingent upon getting funding from the Legislature for 2007. 13. Tokeena Crossroads 2006, Oconee County 1,086 Acres. Amount Requested: \$2,714,934 Staff Recommendation: Grant of \$2,714,934

This proposal was made two years ago for \$6 million. At that time, it did not receive a NRCS grant. It has now received a grant and has been resubmitted. It is the NRCS number one priority in South Carolina. It is a working farm threatened by development. Heather Stevens from NRCS made comments and answered questions. Mr. Tommy Miller made the motion to fund the project in the amount of \$2,714,934. Ms. Andrea Clark seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

14. Wambaw Tract, Charleston County 100 Acres. Amount Requested: \$250,000 Staff Recommendation: Grant of \$250,000

This tract is located across from the St. James – Santee Church. It is a historical Church where a signer of the Declaration of Independence is buried. Mr. Bud Hill, from the Village Museum made comments and answered questions. Mr. Weston Adams made the motion to fund the project in the amount of \$250,000. Mr. Elliott Close seconded the motion, and the motion was approved, with Chairman Lane recused to vote.
